Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to introduce our updated and structured homework policy for all students at Clifton Community School. This new framework is designed to create a consistent and manageable workload, foster excellent study habits, and strengthen the partnership between students, teachers, and parents in supporting your child's learning journey.

#### Why Homework is Essential

Regular, meaningful homework is a vital part of a student's education. It reinforces classroom learning, builds independence, and prepares students for the rigours of future examinations. Our homework tasks are designed to achieve three key goals:

- **Recall:** To consolidate knowledge and embed key facts learned in class.
- **Application:** To use learned skills and knowledge in new or practical contexts.
- **Extension:** To challenge students to explore topics more deeply, conduct research, and prepare for upcoming lessons.

By establishing strong routines at home and school, students develop the organisation, resilience, and time-management skills that are fundamental for academic success.

#### **Weekly Homework Timetable**

We expect students to spend approximately 20-30 minutes per subject on their homework, totalling up to one hour per evening. Please find enclosed at the end of this letter the homework schedule for each year group.

- To ensure homework is accessible to all students, using online platforms effectively.
- To provide timely and constructive feedback to help students improve.
- To be available to support students who are having difficulty with their work.
- To offer Homework Club each day after school students are welcome to attend and access our computer facilities after school each day. This club takes place in the hub.

# **Student Expectations:**

- To listen to instructions in class and check online platforms for homework details.
- To take responsibility for recording homework in their school diary (given out this week).
- To complete and submit all homework by the deadline.
- To complete all work to the best of their ability.
- To manage their time effectively, spending approximately 20-30 minutes per subject.
- To act on feedback provided by their teachers.
- To ask for help from their teacher *before* the deadline if they are finding the work challenging.

# **How You Can Support (Parent & Carer Expectations):**

- Provide a suitable environment: Encourage your child to work in a guiet, dedicated space, away from distractions like television or mobile phones.
- Establish a routine: Help your child get into the habit of completing homework at a set time each evening.
- Show an interest: Ask your child about their homework and what they are learning. This values their effort and reinforces its importance.
- Encourage independence: Support your child by discussing ideas, but encourage them to complete the work themselves.
- Monitor workload: Familiarise yourself with the timetable below and contact us if you have concerns about the amount or difficulty of the work.

We firmly believe that by working together, we can help your child develop the skills and confidence to thrive. Thank you for your continued partnership and support.

Our homework calendar is designed to support parents in guiding home learning. The calendar helps to structure recommended times when students should complete homework assignments, without creating the burden of multiple homework deadlines. Homework activities may be assigned on platforms before the recommended day on the calendar.

Teachers will make the specific schedule clear to students. Many subjects will set homework via online platforms, such as SENECA and CompleteMaths, and students will receive all necessary guidance and login details at school. Some subjects also utilise Google Classroom as the main platform for setting homework activities.
